
Dear Mr. Riebe:

In connection with its investigation into the death of President John F. Kennedy, the Select Committee on Assassinations would like to speak to you regarding your presence at the autopsy of President Kennedy. This letter serves as notification that notwithstanding any order of silence it is permissible for you to divulge information concerning the autopsy to this Committee.

The attached letters from the Department of Defense and the Department of Navy are affirmative responses to the Committee's request that the Defense Department rescind the order of silence. The Committee requested the Defense Department to contact you directly but the Department stated that the Committee could distribute the attached letters and that this would suffice to allow you to speak with the Committee.
