**TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND LOU DESCHLER
(to Mr. Deschler)**

LBJ: Lou? We're having some State visitors here..January.. and I don't want to get it around the period that's likely we'll be having the State of the Union... can you give me any indication about when they have ...have them come in ...about the normal time.. that we can expect them?

LD Who..these visitors, or what?

LBJ No... when you're ready for the State of the Union ..when you come back in?

LD Oh, well...we come back in on the third unless they're going to fix another date..now, there's been some talk that if adjourn...just ahead of Christmas...they might want to put the date off ...I think the 3d of next year comes on a Friday...they want to put it off until the following Wednesday. Now that's about all I know about that business at the time.

LBJ So it would likely be before the 10th then.. wouldn't it?

LD That we come back, yes. And I assume that you'd probably want to come down the second day after we meet...wouldn't you?

LBJ Yes

LD If we meet on a Wednesday..you'll want to come on a Thursday...

LBJ Yes. OK...that's exactly what I want to know.
