On the 8th of July I and my wife went into the American Embassy, I cannot write you what I went on there, because it is Russian, Read all letters going in and out. But anyway I have the American Passport, and we are doing everything we can to get out.

You don't know what a trial this is. I could write a book about how many feelings have come and gone since that day.

The Russians can be cruel and very crude at times. They put a cruel explanation to my wife on the first day we came back from Moscow. They abused every thing because they were angry, and read three meals.

but we shall continue to try and get out. We shall not retreat. As for your package we never received it, I suppose they swept that to the bastards.

I hope someday, I'll see you and Vada but if and when I come, I'll come with my wife. you can't imagine how wonderful she stood up.
