HERBERT E. KRAMER, 10000 Jolly Avenue, Dallas, Texas, advised that he had known JACK RUBY for a number of years. He said RUBY had lived in Dallas, Texas, for one and a half years.

However, he went to the office of the Dallas Police Department and advised the officers that he had never seen RUBY. He advised that from his knowledge of RUBY he did not believe RUBY to be a "homosexual".

KRAMER advised he has never been arrested; that he is 29 years of age, that he has never been married.
