Sure hope you get to go to school. What did you do aboard ship? Scrub decks? Et what!

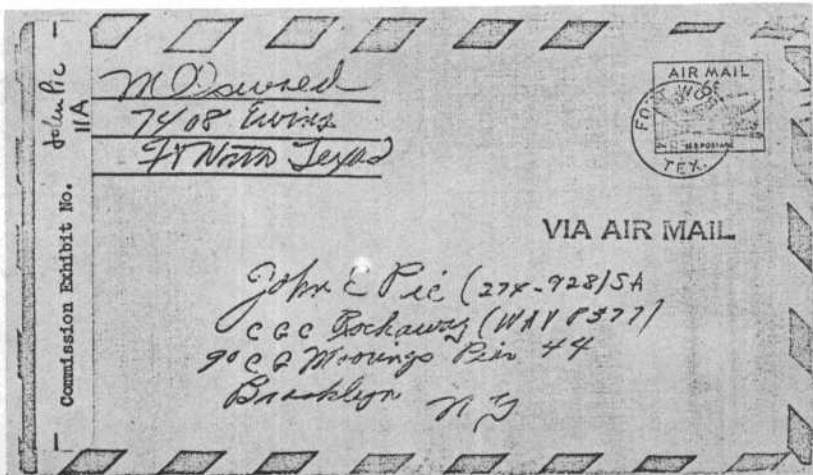
