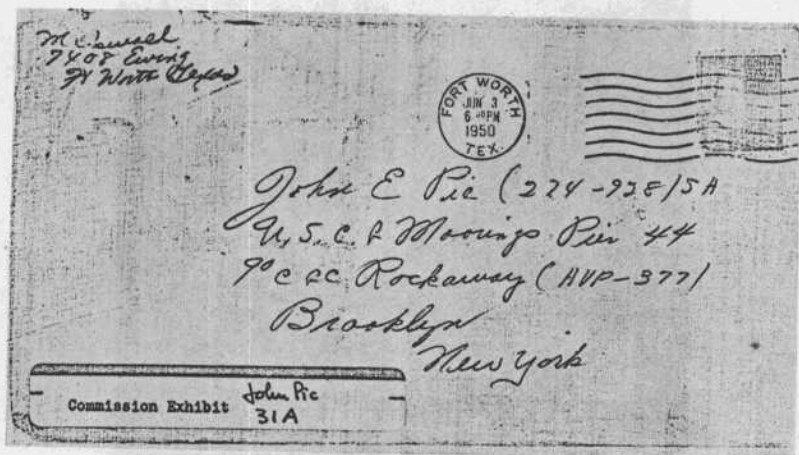

It is very easy to drink etc

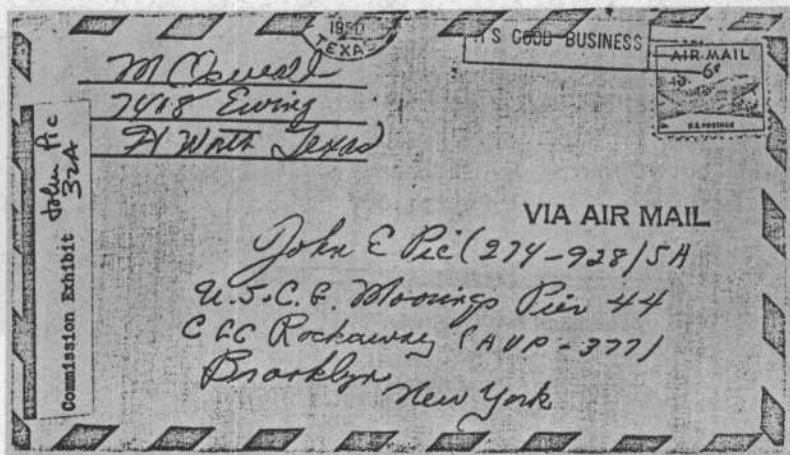
