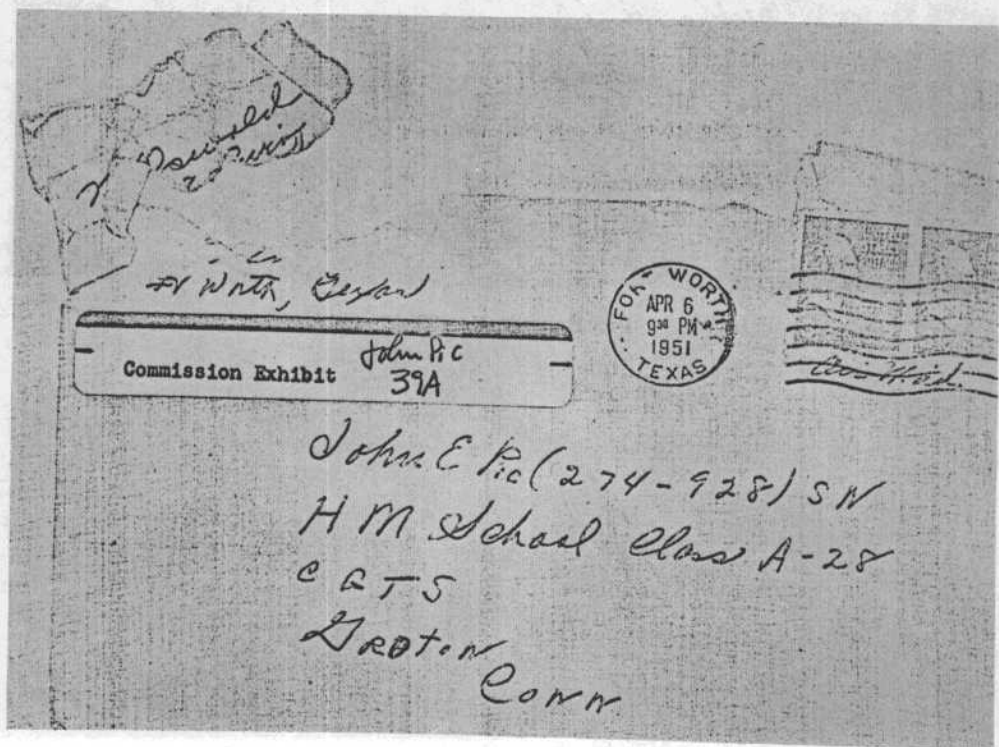
Mother has been sick in bed for the

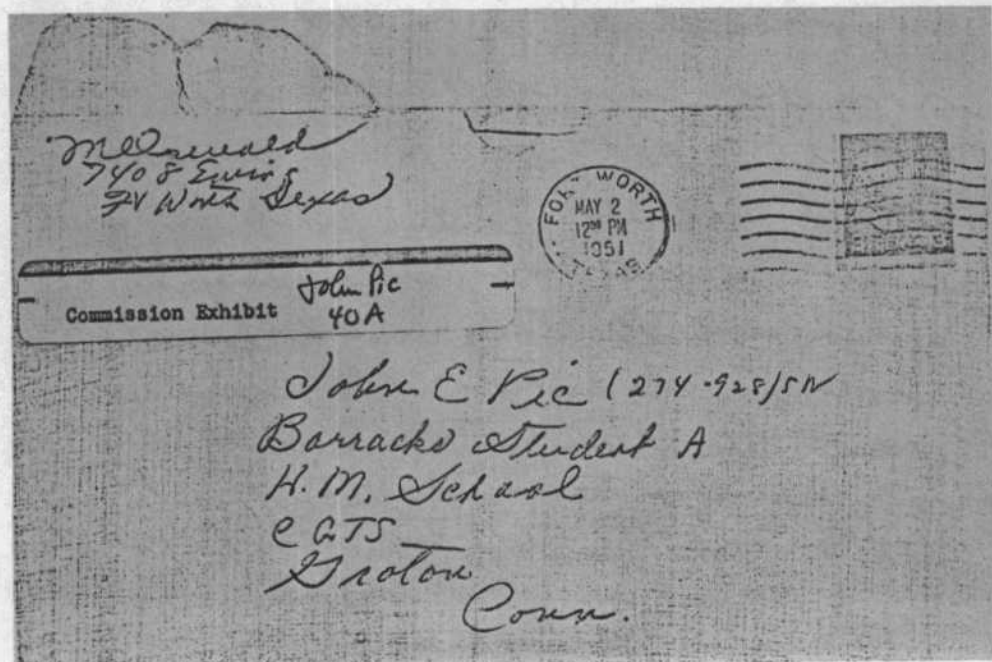
