Third American in 2 Months Leaves Soviet 'Home'

MOSCOW, June 3 (UPI)—An American Embassy official here said today that the U.S. Embassy in Moscow has received word that a third American, David Lee Harvey, has returned to the United States after being held in the Soviet Union for two months.

The man, identified as David Lee Harvey, was the first American to be released from the Soviet Union after being held there for two months. He was released on May 28, 1962, after being held in the Soviet Union for two months.
