Dear Dr. Aguilar:

This is in reply to your March 2 and March 7, 2005, letters to Steven Tilley concerning documents in the John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection. Specifically, you requested that this unit conduct further searches for FBI documents related to a request you made in June of 1999. Stuart Culy, then an archivist with the Special Access and FOIA Staff, sent you several documents responsive to your inquiries concerning FBI efforts to confirm the chain of custody of CE 399 on July 16, 1999. You contend in your most recent letter that FBI 302s of interviews with specific individuals concerning CE 399 should be in the files, but were not found by Mr. Culy during his original search.

We have carefully reviewed Mr. Culy's response, have conducted additional searches in the John F. Kennedy Assassination Collection Reference System, and manually reviewed the pertinent sections in the Dallas Field Office file on Lee Harvey Oswald, the Washington Field Office File on the assassination, and the Headquarters file on the assassination. Our searches have uncovered no additional material.

That said, we cannot say with absolute certainty that the documents you are looking for do not exist somewhere in the FBI's extensive files on the assassination. You are welcome to come here and examine any of our materials in our Research Room.

Finally, please be advised that Steven Tilley is no longer head of the Special Access and FOIA Staff. Please direct future correspondence to me.
